ADVANCE – What is it about?

The Advance Project is set to bridge the divide between HoReCa businesses and municipalities, paving the way for a harmonious circular economy. By analyzing the existing gaps between these two vital entities, we aim to unlock innovative solutions that will revolutionize waste management practices. Together, we will work towards a shared vision of a greener, waste-free world!







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The ADVANCE project will create an innovative framework that will aim to create a strategic educational, training and awareness alliance, aiming to achieve the ambitious target regarding food waste, between Municipalities and Small and Medium Enterprises so that both parties can implement smoothly and effectively the shift towards Circular Economy practices. A growing and active ADVANCE online community will be created, with main objective to enable HoReCa Businesses and Municipalities to become competent in the area of Circular Economy and Waste Management.



Results:

- ✓ Baseline Assessment on Waste Management: An Online baseline assessment which will be based on local surveys, in households and HORECA SMEs, that aim to characterize food waste behaviors, identify crucial links and quantify specific material streams.
- ✓ Gap Analysis Methodology and Tool: An online tool hosted in ADVANCE Online Platform that will be used as a mechanism in which target groups will be enabled to assess their overall competences, capability and skills on Circular Economy and Waste Management processes.
- ✓ ADVANCE Roadmap: Two different Roadmaps, one for municipalities and one for the SMEs in the HORECA sector in order to achieve the food waste targets set by the EU and the SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals).
- ✓ ADVANCE Course: A curriculum broken down into certain learning modules, covering areas of the whole spectrum of Municipal CE and will be suitable for the defined target groups.

The project is conducted by a consortium of 7 partners from 5 European countries: Greece, Cyprus, Serbia, Belgium and Croatia.



Novi Sad is the administrative, economic, cultural, scientific and touristic centre of the Autonomous Province of Vojvodina and the second largest city in Serbia.

Geographically, Novi Sad is in a favourable position. It lies on important transit routes, which provides significant comparative assets.

Novi Sad is connected to the region with road and railway routes as well as waterways. It is in the centre of a highway network connecting Northeastern and Eastern Europe to the Middle and Far East, as well as Central and Northern Europe to the ports of the Adriatic Sea.

The city lies on the European Corridor 10 which connects eight countries on its main route from Salzburg to Thessaloniki, and another six countries with its side routes. The European Corridor 7, or the Danube River waterway, connects Western European countries to the Black Sea. Novi Sad is also connected with the Danube – Tisa – Danube canal system, which enables navigation from the Central Europe to the Black Sea. Novi Sad is located on 1,225th kilometre of the Danube flow. The river is wide here and it forms numerous islands, inlets and sandbanks.

According to the 2022 population Census, 368,967 inhabitants live in the City of Novi Sad, and 260,438 inhabitants live in Novi Sad settlement.

Nowadays, a widely recognizable symbol of the City is Exit Festival, while in the past, and even so today that place has been reserved for the Serbian cultural institutions: Matica srpska - the oldest cultural-scientific institution of Serbia, Serbian National Theatre, Sterijino pozorje Theatre Festival... Furthermore, our City, in contrast to many other European destinations, has the reputation, by full right, of a multinational, multicultural and multi-confessional metropolis in which all differences are seen as advantages. The witnesses to that are Novi Sad Theatre/Újvidéki Színház and University of Novi Sad with 14 faculties and specialized departments at which the lectures are held in languages of national minorities or were founded with that purpose. Still, there are so many other things that represent a daily, lively routine of Novi Sad.



Žana Klarić


